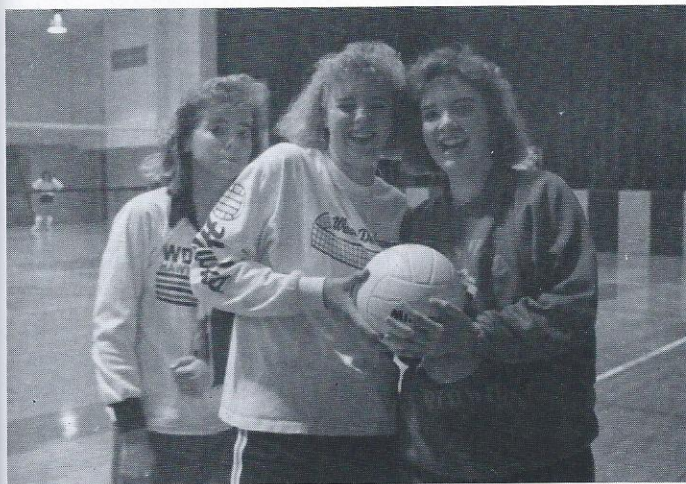


Varsity Volleyball has 6-16-5 Season
